- 3. Length: The regular plenary talks (20+7 min) will be assigned EIGHT (8) pages. The shorter plenary talks (15+5 min) will be assigned FIVE (5) pages. The Summary talk will have FIFTEEN (15) pages.
- 4. Colour: Contributions must be submitted in Black \& White. It is a matter of finances. So please make every effort to ensure that the figures, and captions apropos of figures, are readable when printed and convey the information. Although colours are lovely, Black \& White can be dark and deep.
- 5. Submission: Kindly submit your contribution in PDF format uploading it to http://indico.cern.ch/conferenceDisplay.py?confld=36845 (the INDICO page for the BEACH conference). Using the E-mail you communicated to the Secretariat you will be able to login (top right corner of window) in order to upload your contribution. Your paper will be refereed and we will get back to you with her/his comments. Please contact us if you encounter problems with INDICO or have any question or suggestion.
